

Member State laboratories with capability to test soft fruits for norovirus and hepatitis A virus, version 15 date 2019-11-13

Please note. This document has been prepared by the EURL for monitoring bacteriological and viral contamination of bivalve molluscs in cooperation with the EU network of NRLs and other European laboratories. It is now updated by EURL for Foodborne Viruses. The intent is to provide a guide to Member State Competent Authorities and others wishing to identify laboratories able to supply virus testing services for soft fruits. Laboratories included on this list have indicated that they are able to perform analysis of soft fruits according to methods compliant with ISO TS 15216-2 or its derivatives and were, in principle, willing to offer a testing service. Inclusion on this list does not constitute endorsement of the quality of test results by the EURL, nor does it constitute approval of the laboratory as an Official Control Laboratory by the national Competent Authority. It is recommended that individual parties come to a separate agreement over acceptance of laboratory quality systems.
