	<p>I, the undersigned inspector hereby certify regarding the above described, that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The shell eggs <sup>(2)</sup> come from animals, which were born and reared in ....., an EU Member State approved for export of eggs to Singapore.</li> <li>2. The country of origin of the animals from which the shell eggs were derived has been free from high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI) for the past twelve (12) months prior to export or the past 28 days following a stamping out policy in accordance with WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code <sup>(3)</sup>.</li> </ol> <p>OR</p> <p>The shell eggs were not derived from birds originating from areas within 10 km surveillance zone(s) established around a HPAI-affected farm <sup>(3)</sup>.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. The eggs are unfertilized and derived from layer flocks kept in a farm accredited for the import of eggs by Singapore Food Agency.</li> <li>4. The farm where the eggs originate has been tested and found to be free from <i>Salmonella</i> Enteritidis, and no case of Newcastle disease has been diagnosed on the farm for the last three (3) months prior to export.</li> <li>5. The eggs have a fully developed shell and were clean, fresh and fit for human consumption.</li> <li>6. The eggs have been handled and packed in appropriately sanitised packaging materials and containers in a hygienic manner.</li> <li>7. The eggs have not been added with additives and/or colouring matters injurious to health.</li> <li>8. The eggs must be labelled with a unique identifier code, issued by the country's competent authority or Singapore Food Agency, to identify the producing farm.</li> </ol>
