All products produced in the EU containing raw materials of animal origin are regarded as safe and fit for human consumption. The EU has implemented limits for harmful radioactive contamination and official surveillance programs of foodstuff for content of isotopes and on the general situation concerning radioactive fall-out in EU.
