- (1) For railway wagons or lorries, the registration number should be given, for aircraft the flight number, for vessels the name.
- (2) The signature and stamp must be of a different colour to that of the print.
- (3) The competent authority of Sweden shall immediately inform the Korean government of the outbreak. Article 14 shall apply instead of Article 4(1) from the Import Health Requirement for pork meat and pork products from Sweden. When the Korean government has serious and reasonable doubts confirmed by evidence that disease control measures against ASF in Sweden have not been effective enough to guarantee the safety of the exported goods and to contain the disease, the Korean government may choose to not accept the declaration of the disease free zones and stop the import from Sweden.
