<p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian inspector, hereby certify that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The meat is derived from: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. animals born and raised in Sweden,⁽³⁾ b. animals imported from countries recognized to be eligible to export the pig meat to the Republic of Korea and raised in the country of export for more than three months before slaughter.⁽³⁾ 2. Sweden has been free from foot and mouth disease and classical swine fever for the last 12 months, from vesicular stomatitis, swine vesicular disease (SVD) and rinderpest for the last 24 months and from African Swine Fever for the last 3 years, prior to export. However, in case the Korean Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Rural Affairs recognizes that an effective stamping-out policy for the above diseases is in place in the exporting country, the period may be shortened in accordance with the OIE regulations. 3. Vaccination is not practiced for any of the aforementioned diseases. 4. The meat is derived from pigs born and raised on farms that were free from Brucellosis for at least the past 3 years, free from anthrax for at least the past 2 years, and free from Aujeszky's disease for at least the past 1 year prior to slaughter; the farm is not located in an area which is under the quarantine control of the veterinary authority of the exporting country, in relation to prevent the spread of diseases.

The establishment(s) for export are approved or registered and controlled by the competent authorities of Sweden in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 and 853/2004, and are registered with the Korean government. The establishment(s) for export are under official sanitary supervision by the Swedish authorities and non-compliances have not been detected on the regular sanitary inspections.</p> <p>6. The products come from establishment(s) implementing a programme based on the HACCP principles in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004; and has maintained the relevant records for more than two years.</p> <p>7. Establishment for export is not located in areas contaminated with an outbreak of, or in the quarantine areas for the following diseases: Aujeszky's disease, Anthrax, Brucellosis.</p> <p>8. Establishment for export do not process or handle meat for export to Korea at the same time with cloven-footed animals or their products that are produced or have passed through countries not allowed to export to Korea.</p> <p>9. The pig meat is derived from healthy pigs that have been examined and passed ante-mortem and post-mortem veterinarian inspection at the establishment for export and were found healthy and classified as fit for human consumption without any restriction in compliance with EU regulation; the pig meat has been examined for trichinellosis, <i>Yersinia enterocolitica</i> and echinococcosis with negative results, and is therefore considered to be fit for human consumption;</p> <p>10. While slaughtering, cutting, processing, packing, and storage are done to produce pork meat, etc., animals and products thereof in lower sanitation levels shall not be handled in the same place and meat used as raw material for manufacture of processed meat products shall be eligible to be exported to Korea.</p> <p>11. The pig meat, etc. meet the relevant regulations of the Korean government in regard to residues posing hazard to public health (antibiotics, pesticides, hormones, etc.), microorganisms, irradiation, ionization, and food additives (preservatives, tenderizers, etc.), etc. Pork meat and products thereof were treated in safe manner so as to prevent contamination with any pathogenic organisms.</p> <p>12. The packaging materials used in packing pork meat is sanitary and not injurious to humans. The approval number of the export establishment and the qualification mark are marked on the product or on the package in compliance with EU regulation. The qualification mark verifies that the meat has been treated in a manner not harmful to public health. The mark must be notified to the Korean government in advance.</p>
